

# Special Issue: Non-coding RNAs in Response and Resistance to Therapy in Cancer

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## Introduction:

Non-coding RNAs (ncRNAs) have been identified to be key players in health and disease which are deregulated in cancer which can influence the development of resistance to treatment. This special issue summarizes recent advances on the impact of ncRNAs on therapy resistance in cancer and highlights how ncRNA expression profiles can predict clinical outcome in cancer.
